## Coaching in Early Intervention Partnering with Early Childhood Programs



As an early interventionist, I will partner with the family and you to learn what's most important to support the child's development in your program.

I'll show you new strategies, as needed.

I'll demonstrate and model new strategies in ways that you prefer.

Ask me lots of questions!

- Say "Why" - What is the purpose of activity.

**Together.** with the family, we'll develop a plan for success.

**We'll work** together to support the child's participation within the daily routines of your program.

I'll guide you through new strategies.

Tell me what you're thinking. I'll let you know what I think, too.

We'll figure out how to keep the family involved/informed.





Your turn to practice!

I'll observe and give you hints and reminders here and there.

Continue to ask any questions.

Let me know what is working or not.

We can adjust the plan to meet your needs.
